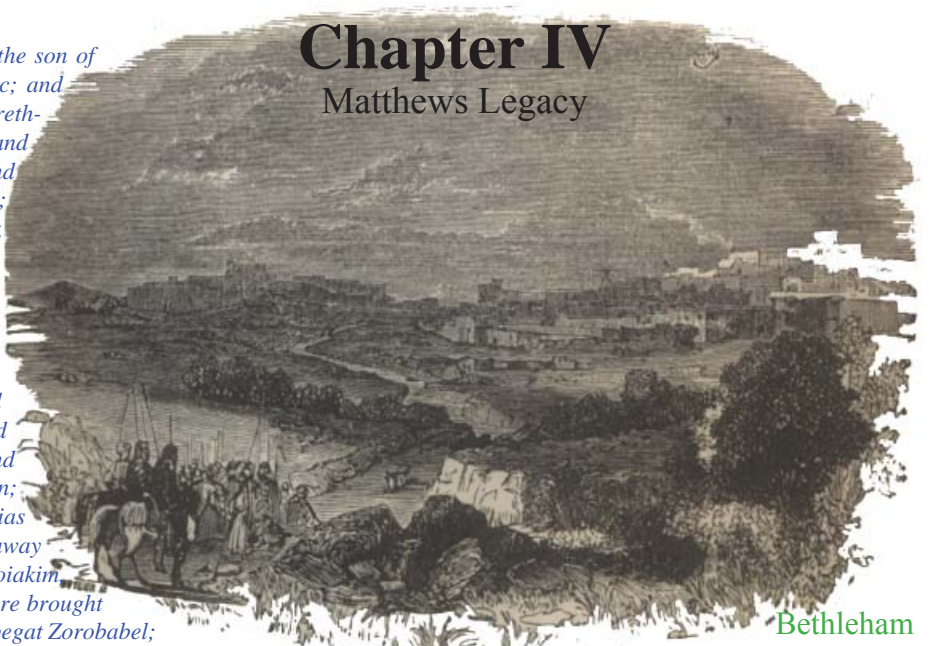


## Matthew 1:1-17

## Chapter IV Matthews Legacy

It is often said that truth is stranger than fiction. Matthew 1 is classic example of that statement. Matthew 1 starts the New Testament with a genealogy of Yashua (Jesus). This list has caused consternation and controversy for almost 2000 years. At the root of the controversy lies the fact that this list of Yashua's genealogy through Joseph (the husband of Mary) is not true to the Old Testament account. Now before you lose interest and wonder what in the world this has to do with Daniel 9 and the 70 "weeks" vision, I will tell you up front, this supposed inaccurate list in fact provides a key to unlocking this prophetic vision.

As we saw in Section I, chapters 1-9, Chronology of a Captive People, the Divine command to "*restore and build*" was given in the 2nd year of Darius (Hystaspes). It was in his reign the Biblical heroes Ezra, Nehemiah, and Esther lived their lives. It is here where the Old Testament narrative and chronology ends. The silence of the Scripture over the next 500 years is bridged only by the Countdown to the Messiah. At the other end of this silence the gospel of Matthew speaks in chapter 1 with the lineage of the Yashua (Jesus) through Joseph his legal father.

A close look at the genealogy of Yashua as given in Matthew reveals some interesting information. I believe there are basically 3 ways to look at this list of Matthew. First, it is falsification of the facts of Yashua's true lineage. Second, the list has been mistranslated from its original source. Third, the list is not meant to be a true list of the genealogy of Yashua but it is "constructed" according to Hebrew custom in order to bring symbolic attention to some other idea or fact. A misunderstanding of the intent of the author of the list could therefore be misconstrued as a falsification or a mistranslation. There is really no way to conclusively prove or disprove the first two possibilities mentioned above. So instead, let's see if we can find an intelligent reason for the apparent discrepancy in this list. We will closely examine this lineage and see if we can figure out the intent of Matthew when he wrote this puzzling list.

In **Table 4.1** (below) you will find the list of Matthew 1 as given. You will also find the list of Matthew correct according to I Chronicles 3. An interesting feature of this list is its groupings. Matthew 1:17 states: *17 So all the generations from Abraham to David are fourteen generations; and from David until the carrying away into Babylon are fourteen generations; and from the carrying away into Babylon unto the Messiah are fourteen generations.* It is obvious right up front this is not a standard list of Yashua ancestors. First of all, in the counting of 14 generations, David is mentioned at the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> 14 generations as well as the beginning of 2<sup>nd</sup> set of 14 generations. This is obviously a double count. (Biblical fact: David's name also has the numerical value of 14)

2<sup>nd</sup> if this is supposed to be a true representation of Yashua’s family tree why is an event mentioned ( “carrying away into Babylon” ) at the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 14 generations as well as at the start of the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 14 generations? What family tree counts events as generations instead of people? It seems obvious here 14 generations are important to whatever point the author is trying to make. It is just as obvious, if we accept that this list is written as was intended, this is not an ordinary every day representation of Yashua’s genealogy. Understanding the list is even further complicated if you realize the author left out 4 names completely! The 4 names left out are Ahaziah, Joash, Amaziah and Jehoiakim. If you look at **Table 4.1** you will see the missing names in red. Those who do not believe Matthew 1 was an inspired account of Yashua’s life are probably pretty excited right now. Those who think we can only understand this if we somehow find a more accurate translation or we need a better understanding of Hebrew or Greek are probably feeling vindicated, as well. My question is what if we are missing the true intent of this list of the “generations” of Yashua?

Let’s look at some of what we do know. The list in Matthew as given has 41 individual names on it. Abraham starts the 1<sup>st</sup> grouping of 14 generations and David ends it. David’s name is repeated at the start of the 2<sup>nd</sup> grouping of 14 generations and the “carrying away into Babylon” ends it. The “carrying away into Babylon” starts the 3<sup>rd</sup> grouping of 14 generations and Yashua ends it. If we count the 2<sup>nd</sup> grouping of 14 generations using the names given, starting with David it ends with king Josias. Now Josias is the father of Jehoiakim. Jehoiakim is one of the names missing on the list. Historically it was during Jehoiakim’s reign that Nebuchadnezzar first subdued Jerusalem and took captives. The prophet Daniel was among the first captives taken. It is interesting that this “error” in the list of Matthew 1 draws our attention to the time when Daniel was taken captive by Nebuchadnezzar. Coincidence?

**Daniel 1:1-2**

*In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah came Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon unto Jerusalem, and besieged it. 2 And יהויה gave Jehoiakim king of Judah into his hand, with part of the vessels of the house of God: which he carried into the land of Shinar to the house of his god; and he brought the vessels into the treasure house of his god.*

Now Josias ends the 2<sup>nd</sup> grouping of 14 generations from David. The next name on the list is the grandson of Josias namely Jechonias. Starting with Jechonias as the first name of the 3<sup>rd</sup> grouping of 14 generations as given on the list we come to Yashua as the last name on the list of 14 generations. If we accept the list at face value and not as a true “genealogical representation” we find it fulfills all the criteria as a “arranged” list of 3 groupings of 14 generations. But this still does not quite satisfy the facts of the list of Matthew.

We have looked at the grouping of 14 generations as arranged by Matthew. Now lets look at the names as given and not as they are “arranged”. Counting out the 1st, 14 names on the list of Matthew we start with Abraham and end with David. Counting the next 14 names on the list we start with Solomon and ends with Jechonias. Now counting the final names on the list we start with Salathiel and end with Yashua. Now for those who were counting you realized there are only 13 names from Salathiel to Yashua. It could be said that Matthew 1 was intended, as arranged to represent 3 groupings of 14 generations. (14+14+14) When we read the list as it was actually written we see only 41 names. (14+14+13) There are in reality 2

sets of 14 names and one set with 13 names. Another way of looking at this list would be that Yashua as intended was the 14<sup>th</sup> generation and as given was in reality the 13<sup>th</sup> generation. Yashua as given became flesh and dwelt (tabernacled) among us. Yashua as intended was the perfect spiritual and literal sacrifice. When Yashua rose from the grave and was “born again” He literally became the 14<sup>th</sup> generation. Yashua as given was 6+7=13. Yashua as intended was 7+7=14. In the Scripture the number 6 is representative of man and our labor under the curse of sin. The number 7 is representative of Divine perfection and rest.

When looking at the list of Matthew your attention is drawn to 2 focal points in relation to Abraham and the Messiah. One is King David. The 2<sup>nd</sup> is the Babylonian captivity of Judah. If you look under the surface of the latter you will see the 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> generations meet at the point when Daniel was carried away to the Babylonian captivity. You will also see as we have shown in **Chronology of a Captive People**, Daniel is the chronological starting place for all the events leading up to the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of Darius I and the Divine command to “restore and build”.

Some other interesting features of this list of Matthew deserves mention here. The 1st is there are 41 names in the list of Matthew 1. As mentioned in the last chapter, Daniel’s 70th “week” finds itself within a bigger Biblical pattern of 70 years and 70 Jubilees. Interestingly Abraham

who starts this list in Matthew was born during the 41st Jubilee from Adam. 41 is the 13th prime number. (not counting 1) If 1 is considered a prime number then 41 is the 14th prime number. (6 is to 13 what 13 is to 41)

In **Table 4.3** the listed generations from Yashua to Abraham is continue back to Adam and YHWH. According to the Septuagint text of the Scripture there would be 66 generations from Yashua to YHWH. The most common version of the New Testament today has 66 books, from Genesis (YHWH) to Revelation (Yashua). Using the MT text of the Scripture there are 65 generations from Yashua to YHWH. or (5x13)
